Summary of actions taken at meeting:

Call to Order & Introductions

Brett M. called the meeting to order and the agenda was adopted.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Tom S. reviewed the minutes from the February 8, 2023 Council meeting and, after being moved and seconded, the Council members **APPROVED** the minutes.

Treasury Management & Coin Economics Committee Report

Dr. Leemon B. shared that CoinCom is consistently seeing high attendance and engaged participation. CoinCom is currently analyzing Hedera's token economics model and staking program.

Betsabe B. discussed the Treasury Management Report published in December 2022, as well as forthcoming Q1 2023 updates. Betsabe discussed the "illiquid supply" category that will be added to the Treasury Management Report beginning in 2023. This category, defined as "the portion of released supply that is controlled by a member of the public but is known by Hedera to have contractual or self-imposed limitations on ownership transfer," has always been included in the narrative to the report but will now be extracted and highlighted for clarity.

Technical Steering & Product Committee Report

Dr. Leemon B. shared that, immediately prior to the meeting, the Hedera network had crossed the milestone of having processed five billion transactions.

Dr. Leemon B. updated Council on TechCom's recent discussions, which include the decision to conditionally approve HIP 657 (mutable metadata fields for dynamic NFTs). TechCom's roadmap remains unchanged. Dr. Leemon B. discussed signing readiness and thanked transaction signers for their attention to recent time-sensitive signings.

Membership Committee Report

Simon O. updated Council members that MemCom is conducting robust discussion around Hedera's membership strategy, and the criteria prospective members must satisfy to apply for Council membership. Simon O. specifically thanked the new members who have been adding significant value to these discussions.

Simon O. discussed the remaining Council vacancies and the terms of current Council members. Simon O. shared that recently, Council members have been discussing Hedera within their networks and educating prospective members about Council membership, which has generated high-quality candidates. Simon O. encouraged existing Council members to continue identifying organizations that could serve as effective Council members.

Corporate Utilization Committee Report

Andy G. shared that CorpCom has been experiencing strong attendance from both Council members and invited experts in the industry. At its last themed meeting, CorpCom hosted two organizations that presented innovative solutions in the ESG and sustainability space.

Andy G. shared that the next CorpCom meeting will focus on digital identity. Brett M. shared that Hedera will continue to provide thought leadership on digital identity use cases following its presentation on this topic at the World Economic Forum in Davos.

Legal & Regulatory Committee Report

Rich W. updated Council that RegCom is seeing increased engagement and sophisticated discussions around regulatory issues and strategy. Recent discussions include the scope of RegCom's activities, which RegCom described in a proposed amendment to its charter. RegCom also has been discussing recent staking-as-a-service enforcement actions and related topics.

The Council then went into executive session, during which the Council discussed RegCom's proposed amended charter, which included a name change from the Legal & Regulatory Committee to the Regulatory & Policy Committee. The genesis of this change is RegCom's increased focus on proactive efforts to shape the global regulatory landscape. After being moved and seconded, the Council **APPROVED** the revised charter for the newly renamed Regulatory & Policy Committee. The Council then exited the executive session.

Marketing Committee Proposal

Christian H. discussed a proposal to reactivate the Marketing Committee, which was formed in May 2019 but dissolved in May 2021. A newly revived MarCom would provide oversight and advice to Council on marketing programs. Christian H. informed Council members that MarCom is seeking representation from marketing teams within Council member organizations, several of which have already been confirmed. Hedera Staff will call for nominations for MarCom co-chairs, and the Council is expected to vote on whether it will revive MarCom at an upcoming Council meeting.

The Council then entered into executive session. After exiting executive session, Brett M. reminded Council members that Hedera is currently sourcing candidates for a Chief Open Source Officer and encouraged Council members to notify qualified individuals in their networks.

The meeting was adjourned.
